How Does Direct Primary Care Work?

Members on the \$12,000 AHP who use a Direct Primary Care provider can submit up to \$1,800 of their DPC fees for sharing. If the Annual Household Portion (AHP) has not been met, the Direct Primary Care fees will be applied directly to the AHP.
